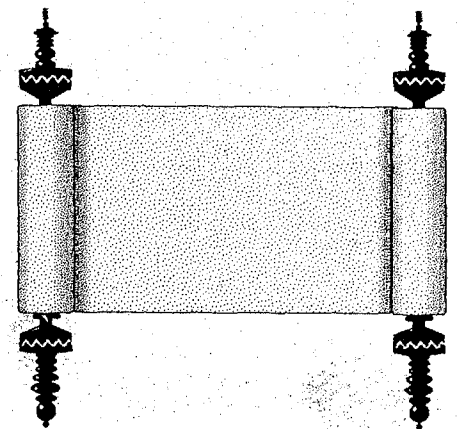

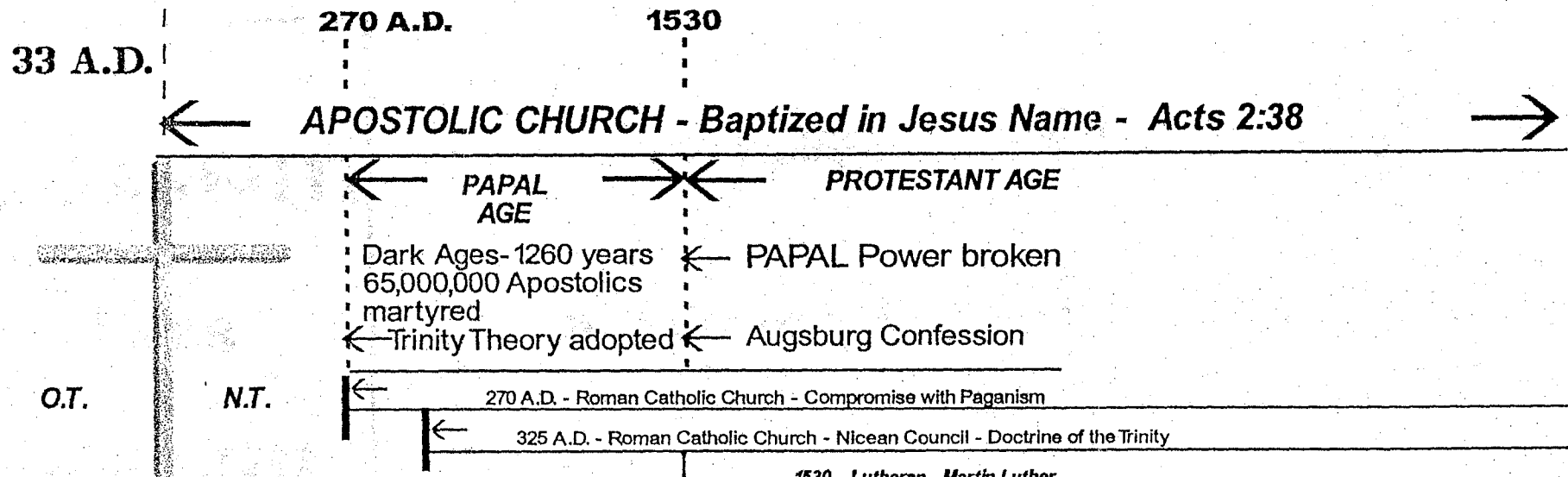
Repent, and be baptized in the NAME of Jesus Christ ...

JESUS is the Father, the Son, the Holy Ghost, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace, the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, the Bright and Morning Star, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the Ending, the One that was, and is and is to come. THE ALMIGHTY.

Every Apostle, every disciple, every writer of the New Testament was baptized in Jesus' Name. Not one ever used the words Father, Son and Holy Ghost in baptism. Why do you?

The original and ONLY true Church of Jesus Christ started in Jerusalem in the Upper Room on the day of Pentecost, 33 A.D. Since that day many churches have been established but none have conformed to the exact image of the original church. The first false church traces their identity to the beginning of the Papal Age which started about 270 A.D. This is the beginning of what is known as the Dark Ages. This Period continued for about 1260 years until the time of Martin Luther.

History declares that during this time, more than sixty-five million Apostolic Christians were martyred by the Papal Church. In the writings of their own history, they admit to such atrocity but justify themselves by saying that these that followed the original teachings of the Apostles were heretics and deserved to die. Such reasoning is a stench in the nostrils of Almighty God.

In 270 A.D. a man by the name of Tertullian invented the word "Trinity" from which derived the Trinity Doctrine. The words "Trinity" and "Trinity Doctrine" were never known or heard by the Apostles of the Lord Jesus Christ. The Papal Church embraced the Trinity Doctrine from its inception; then in 325 A.D. at the Nicean Council in Nice, Italy, under Pope Constantine, she adopted the Trinity Doctrine. What a sad mistake. God is not a Trinity - God is One.

When the Church of Rome adopted the Trinity Doctrine they also changed the baptism to the Trinity formula, namely "Father, Son, and Holy Ghost." According to the Bible, the early church baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. According to history, this practice was continued for nearly 300 years then changed by the church of Rome.

The Papal powers were broken by the ushering in of the Protestant Age by Martin Luther. Luther, being a Catholic Priest and not satisfied with the Catholic dogma, separated from the Catholic Church. The sad thing is that Luther carried with him many of the Catholic doctrines and teachings such as Trinity, Trinity baptism, the doctrine of sprinkling, and the baptizing of infants.

In 1530 Luther broke away from Catholicism; and since that time you can see, according to the chart, that many man-made churches have arisen because of dissention within different groups. The strange thing is that when each split took place, they carried with them the Catholic doctrine of the Trinity.

Let me ask you- Why not stick to the original teachings of the Apostles and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38). The Apostle Jude said, "Let us earnestly contend for the faith that was once delivered to the Saints (Jude verse 3)."
